🔼 Do the math

Make sure you are getting paid appropriately for your work. For example, a 1500 patient FHO is likely producing, at minimum, \$25K/mo. After overhead this is around 17.5K/mo. This does not include FFS, third-party, preventative bonuses or access bonuses. Of note, this is using \$200/pt/year which is often an underestimate. If you are doing the work, you deserve the pay. *Rates can vary based on circumstance including rurality, inclusion of billings, roster size, call requirements etc.*

Average overhead 30%

FHO/FHN: \$200/pt/year minimum

Contracts

- Have one Ensure reviewed by lawyer
 - Start-End Date
- Daily, on-call and vacations hours
- Remuneration

Clearly defined, roster size on contract

Make sure you have a 30-60 day contract exit, EMR remote access, # pts/day

Negotiation

- They need you
- Ask to see their RA This is your leverage

Confirm appropriate renumeration

Vacation

Long-term locums need vacation too! If covering labs during vacation paid, admin-time pay

Opioids Let them know your comfort, ask about

their population
