Contest Rules and Regulations

The contest is organized by the Ontario Medical Association (OMA) (hereinafter the "Contest Organizer"), and runs from August 2021, to September 19th, 2021 at 12:00 Noon Eastern time.

Eligibility

1. Contest entrants must:

- Reside in Canada with the exception of Quebec; and
- Have attained the age of majority in their province or territory of residence, by August 1st, 2021; and
- Be a first-year medical student at one of the Universities in Ontario; and
- Have signed up for OMA Membership between the period of August 1 and September 19, 2021.
- You are not eligible to enter if you are an employee of the Contest Organizer, OMA or any of its affiliates, subsidiaries, parent or related companies or a member of the immediate family or household of any such employee.

One chance to win per person. All first-year medical students that sign up for OMA membership in the time stipulated above are eligible and will be automatically entered into the draw.

Details of the draw

1. 30 prizes will be awarded - 5 winners will be selected per Medical School by means of a random draw held on September 19, 2021 at 3:00pm.

2. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.
3. Contest entrant means the person whose name, contact information and OMA Membership Number is indicated on the OMA membership registration form.
4. The prizes will be mailed to the winners within four (4) weeks of the draw date.
5. To obtain his or her prize, the winner must meet the eligibility requirements in these rules and:
 - a) be reached by telephone within fifteen (15) business days of the draw; and
 - b) correctly answer a timed mathematical skill-testing question asked over the telephone and,
 - c) accept the prize as awarded.
6. In the event the eligibility requirements above are not met or the winner fails to comply with rule #5, the Contest Organizers will redraw for another winner. This subsequent draw will proceed in the same manner as described in these rules, with the exception of the date.
7. In the event that the Contest Organizers cannot award the prizes as described in these contest rules, they reserve the right to award a like prize of equivalent value or, at their discretion, the prize cash value indicated herein.
8. The Contest Organizers make no warranties, and hereby disclaim any and all warranties, express or implied, concerning the prize awarded in connection with this Contest.
